

Mobile Phone Policy

After due consideration and consultation, the governors and staff of Madresfield C. E. Primary School have agreed the following policy statement relating to the use of mobile telephones in school:

Adults working in school

- Mobile phones must not be used to either respond to or send messages during lesson times.
- The volume control must be silenced at the above times.
- Mobile phones may be used discreetly at break times.
- The school premises must not be used for 'charging' mobile phones
- The only exception to the above is in the case of an emergency when either a child or an adult is in danger and the use of a mobile phone would be the quickest way of summoning assistance.

Children in school

- Children are not allowed mobile phones in school.
- Messages will still be taken at the office and passed on, as has been the tradition.
- If on a rare occasion an exception to this rule is deemed necessary, a parent/guardian must discuss this with the Head Teacher.
- If it is agreed that a phone is essential, then it should be locked in the filing cabinet in the school office (for collection at the end of the day).
